Scheme of Examination:-

First Session

Mental Aptitude Test (MAT) and Language comprehensive test with 45 question items in each, total 90 Questions of multiple choice testing verbal and non-verbal metacognitive abilities like reasoning and critical thinking, The questions in the test may be on analogy, classification, numerical series, pattern perception, hidden figures. of one mark each (90 marks).

Duration of Examination: 90 minutes

Second session

Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) with 90 question items of multiple choice covering subjects namely Science, Social Studies and mathematics as taught in classes VII and VIII. (90 Marks)

Duration of Examination: 90 minutes State Quota allotted: - 1091 students Reservation: -As per State norms.
